To complete their FAFSA or Dream Act, students will need to bring:

- Student's and parent's Social Security number
- Records of untaxed income such as welfare benefits, Social Security benefits, or child support payments
- Student's and parent's W-2 forms or records of income earned
- 2015 bank statements
- Business records
- Permanent resident or DACA card, if you are not a U.S. citizen
- List of colleges you are interested in attending
